## Rudheath Lodge

Sibelco is a leading supplier of specialist sands and clays for a wide range of consumer end uses including glass manufacture (windows, bottles and jars); tableware, sanitaryware; wall tiles; floor tiles; water filtration sands; foundry castings and sports and leisure sands. The UK part of the Company has been based in Cheshire for nearly 40 years and is part of the local communities in which it operates.

The Company has identified a sand resource adjacent to the A50 at Rudheath Lodge. The site is situated in parts of the Parishes of Cranage and Allostock. The Company (formerly British Industrial Sand) operated several sand extraction sites in the local area including what are now known as Shakerley Mere, Dovemere, Sandmere, Boundary Water Park and New Platt Lake.

Sibelco has submitted a Scoping Request to the local authorities. This is not a planning application but is a request for guidance from the authorities on what environmental studies would be required to be undertaken and included in any reports should an application for development come forward. Sibelco is awaiting these responses before proceeding.

Sibelco will be holding a **drop in session** at **Allostock Village Hall** on **Tuesday 14th July** between **4pm and 8pm**. Company representatives will be present to discuss the outline proposals included in the Scoping Request.

There is no need to register, just **come along** anytime between 4pm and 8pm.
