Parish Councillor Vacancies – Cranage

Your Parish Council currently has **two vacancies**. The role doesn't require any specific prior experience, just a willingness to contribute a few hours a month to give back to the community and help further the on-going efforts to improve the local area for everyone.

Cranage Parish Council contributes enormously to the area you live in, some of the improvements we have supported and approved funding for recently include;

- **Improving drainage on both football pitches in the Dane Valley despite in ownership of Cheshire East and their unwillingness to pay to make them playable again.**
- **Installing an equipment store for the football teams in Cranage**
- **Assisting the socially isolated with monthly subsidised luncheons**
- **Building a new Adult Fitness area**
- **Building a teenage play area and recently assisting in refurbishing a brand-new small play area**
- **Ensuring the grass verges are cut six times a year to enable walkers to have better access when walking / jogging into Holmes Chapel**
- **Giving grants/donations to the voluntary organisations which struggle to survive**

The Parish council meets for one evening every month. In between that, matters are managed by e-mail, phone call or occasional ad-hoc meetings with external bodies by arrangement. Without support from people like you, we would struggle to function for the 550 households in our Parish.

Being a Parish Councillor is a really efficient and impactful way to make a valuable contribution to where you live.
